Notice is hereby given that The City of Jamestown's CDBG and HOME FY 2024 Annual Action Plan has been prepared and will be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) pending a mandatory **30-day public review period beginning May 24th**.

The purpose of this public input period is to assist the Department of Development in gaining a better understanding of the housing, neighborhood, and economic development needs to be addressed through the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Program allocations for 2024.

Additionally, it will be made available at Prendergast Library and online at www.jamestownny.gov. **All comments regarding Annual Action Plan will be accepted until June 24, 2024 by 4:00 pm**, in writing to the Department of Development, Municipal Building, Fourth Floor, Jamestown, NY 14701.

The Jamestown City Council and the subsequent submission of the City's FY 2024 CDBG and HOME Annual Action Plan application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development will consider all comments received prior to the formal authorization of the application.
